**REMITTS AND NOTICES OF MOTION FOR AGM – 20 SEPTEMBER 2020**

The Council has received two Remits and two Notices of Motions for consideration at the Associations Annual General Meeting on Sunday 20 September 2020. They are all put forward by the AJPA Council

**Remit One: That submissions be made to parliament to have the official wording of affidavits and declarations in te reo as well as English.**

**Proposer:** AJPA Council

Reasons:

- a. Te reo – Maori is an official language of New Zealand.
- b. Maori be treated as an equal party in justice.
- c. The Oaths and Declarations (Maori Language) Regulations 2004 provided te reo versions of certain oaths and affirmations so this should also be done for Affidavits and Declarations

**Remit Two: That the funding for existing and new service desks paid to associations be for the year ending 30th June instead of 31st August.**

**Proposer:** AJPA Council

Reasons:

- a. To bring the year in line with the Royal Federation financial year.
- b. Logical and easier for associations to follow.
- c. In the year of less than 12 months payment be for 10/12th of the year.

**Motion One (to amend the constitution): That in D3 the date 31 August be amended to 30 June**

**Proposer:** AJPA Council

Reasons:

- a. To bring the year in line with the Royal Federation financial year.
- b. When there was a change to the financial year, other consequential changes were not included
