

Statutory Declaration for Translators/Interpreters

This declaration is intended for use in Citizenship Ceremonies where an applicant is not able to make the Oath /Affirmation in English and requires this to be translated into another language. The Justice may use the declaration for other situations where a translation is required by amending the wording appropriately.
